Hostel Rules and Regulations

A. Hostel Admission

1. Students, who have duly enrolled themselves in a BE programme of study in the institute (Government Engineering College Dahod) and who come from a place 30 or more kilometres away from the institute, can apply for hostel accommodation.
2. Students seeking admission to hostels shall have to apply offline by filling prescribed hostel admission application form as given in **Appendix – I** and also have to furnish the same information on the online form as per the link given in the hostel admission notice (available on the website) within the given time.
3. The filled admission form should be submitted to the hostel rector/warden's office within time.
4. Incomplete application form and non-submission of either offline application form or online form (as per the given link) cancel the name of the student from the admission process.
5. Hostel admission will be given on a merit basis (ACPC merit or immediate previous semester result whichever is applicable), within various categories.
6. The Gujarat State Government category reservation norms will be taken into consideration (as per ACPC guidelines).
7. Based on the available number of vacancies in hostels and intake, the proportionate number of students from each branch of the respective semester will be offered admission as per criteria-6.
8. Preferences will be given to the out-station students who stay more than 30 km away in distance from the institute (GEC Dahod).

9. Failing in hostel fees in the stipulated time (preferable within a week from hostel seat/admission allotment) leads to the cancellation of students' hostel admission and the student will not have any claim in future for hostel admission.
10. All the rights to admission to the hostel are reserved by institute authorities.

B. Accommodation

1. Boys' and girls' hostel accommodation is available to male and female B. E. program students, respectively. No student will have a right to occupancy of a room during vacation. But, he/she may be permitted to stay on request, if he/she is involved in any of the course work/project work/Institute work/hostel work or appearing in university examination.
2. Accommodation would be provided only after paying the requisite fees and rents as decided by the college from time to time. All charges and rents prescribed in the application form or any other documents are subject to change as per the decision of the institute authorities.
3. No students will be allowed to stay in the hostel without formal admission. If any such student is found staying in any hostel room, then the student who has allowed him/her to stay in his/her room will be penalized Rs. 500/- for the first time, Rs.1,000/- for the second time and in third time his/her hostel admission will be cancelled.
4. The hostel administration has the right to refuse admission to anyone and/or withdraw permission already granted if it is found that he/she has submitted incorrect information.
5. The newly admitted student needs to submit their data as per the prescribed form given in **Appendix – II** along with paid fee receipt, copy of caste certificate (if applicable), copy of Aadhar card and copy of parents/guardian Aadhar cards.
6. At the time of admission/room allocation, every student has to submit a written undertaking (as given in **Appendix – III**) in the prescribed form, countersigned by his parent/guardian, to the extent that he/she would abide by the rules and regulations of the hostel.

C. Conditions of Room Allotment

1. At the time of renewal of admission of a student and/or at the beginning of every semester, each student has to submit a duly filled personal data form (as given in **Appendix - IV**) to the respective hostel warden. The personal data form contains students' information such as a current address, mobile number, another contact number, e-mail address, contact

details of parents/guardian(s), etc. Any change in this information at any point in time has to be intimated to the hostel office in writing.

2. The hostel management will generally provide a minimum set of furniture and fittings (as per availability) in each room consisting of a cot for each inmate as well as a table, chair, ceiling fan with regulator and reasonable light fitting.
3. Allotment of rooms shall be the sole discretion of the hostel administration. The room allotment is performed based on available vacancy, merit, category, and department wise. The hostel management has a right to change the admission rule(s) at any time after getting approval from the principal.
4. Rooms once allotted to the student for an academic year will not be changed except under special situations. Under no circumstances the inmates should exchange rooms without the knowledge of the hostel management.
5. Unauthorized occupancy of any room or exchange of room shall be treated as a serious violation of disciplinary rules of the hostel. Students' accommodation can be changed by the management if they found it necessary at any point in time.
6. Once admitted, the student is entitled to accommodation in the hostel as long as he/she is a full-time registered student of the institute. Accommodation will not be provided to any student whose registration is cancelled. Any student, whose name has been removed from the rolls of the institute, will automatically cease to be an inmate of the hostel. Such students should immediately leave the hostel.
7. In case of detention of any student in any academic term, the hostel admission of such student(s) is treated as cancellation and student(s) has to vacate his room immediately.

D. Code of conduct

1. Every admitted student must remember that the hostel is the home of students on the campus therefore, he/she should behave himself/herself on campus as well as outside in such a manner as to bring credit to him/her and the institute.
2. All the admitted students are required to maintain standards of behaviour expected of students of a prestigious institution such as ours. They are expected to behave courteously and fairly with everyone both inside and outside of the campus.

3. All the admitted students are required to carry their valid Identity cards issued to them by the institute.
4. Ragging in any form is banned. Severe punishment, including expulsion from the hostel and/or the institute, shall be imposed on any resident if he/she is found to have indulged in ragging or similar activity.
5. Any type of group gathering in the hostel complex is not permitted without the prior and written consent of the warden/rector/principal.
6. Modesty in dress is expected from students.
7. Silence must be observed on the hostel premises. All unnecessary noises must be avoided.
8. A room is allotted to a student on his responsibility. He/she must take care of the cleanliness and maintenance of his/her room, common room, and surrounding the hostel. Admitted students must also take care of the hostel and its environment. Garbage & wastage only be put in the garbage box(s) available nearby his/her room.
9. Vandalism or destruction is a very serious offence. Any student found guilty of committing such an offence can be expelled from the hostel with a hefty fine.
10. Students have to use water and electricity judiciously. Fans and lights must be switched off when not in use.
11. Pasting of posters, writings, wall chalking, slogans of any kind or defacing of the hostel in any form is not allowed.
12. Students are prohibited from giving shelter to any other student/outsider in the room. In case of any unauthorized shelter, the admission allotted to the student, who has sheltered an unauthorized person, will be penalized Rs. 500/- for the first time, Rs.1,000/- for the second time and for the third time his/her hostel admission will be cancelled.
13. In case of any unacceptable behaviour by the roommate, the other roommate must report to the hostel management.
14. Keeping lethal weapons such as sticks, rods, chains, etc., in the hostel rooms is strictly prohibited.

15. In case a student falls sick, he/she should contact immediately the doctor or warden. In case of an emergency, roommates or friends may shift the patient immediately to the hospital and inform the authorities at the earliest.
16. A student suffering from infectious/contagious diseases will not be permitted to stay in the hostel. The decision of the warden in this regard will be final and binding.
17. The admitted student(s) of the room is responsible for any damage to the property in the room during his/her occupancy or at the time of vacating the room. If any furniture or fixture under the responsibility of the resident is found damaged or broken, the hostel management shall take strict disciplinary action including leaving a monetary penalty equal to the market price of the item or a fine decided by the hostel committee for each item.
18. In case of any damage or loss of hostel property kept in the common area, the cost of repairing/replacing the same will be recovered from the student(s) responsible for such damage or loss if identified; otherwise, the same will be recovered from all the students of the respective block/hostel, as decided by the hostel management.
19. The students shall not remove any fitting or fixture from any room or common area.
20. The admitted students should not participate in any anti-national, anti-social or any other undesirable activity within or outside the campus.
21. The student will be responsible for the safekeeping of their property. In the event of loss of any personal property of a resident due to theft, fire or any other cause, the hostel management shall in no way be considered responsible.
22. All matters relating to differences among students and complaints against theft shall be brought to the notice of the hostel management. No police complaint will be lodged by the student before taking prior permission from the hostel management.
23. On the hostel premises, the following acts are strictly prohibited;
 - I. Smoking/chewing tobacco.
 - II. Gambling
 - III. Intimidation of violence.
 - IV. Willful damage to the hostel property.
 - V. Entering the hostel premises in an intoxicated state.
 - VI. Using abusive languages.
 - VII. Employing unauthorized persons for personal work such as washing clothes, repair of hostel property, tiffin, etc.
 - VIII. Cooking in the room or on the hostel premises.

Student(s) found or involved in such activities will be penalized Rs. 1000/- for the first time, Rs. 2,000/- for the second time and for the third time his/her hostel admission will be cancelled. At the same time, along with the penalty, the student has to pay the repair charges of the damaged items.

24. Consumption of any alcoholic drinks and prohibited drugs is strictly prohibited. Student(s) even found under the influence of alcohol or prohibited drugs within hostel or institute premises, will be immediately expelled from the hostel. At the same time, his/her parent will be informed of such action.
25. The use of electrical appliances such as immersion heaters, any type of stove, electric stove/heater, LPG gas cylinder, any type of inflammable material/liquid, etc., are forbidden in any of the rooms allotted for residence. In such offence, the appliance will be seized and a penalty of Rs. 500/- for the first time, Rs. 1,000/- for the second time and for the third time the hostel admission of the student will be cancelled.
26. The use of audio systems which may cause inconvenience to other occupants is not allowed. The use of personal TV, VCR, and VCD/DVD is prohibited. The students should not hire objectionable audio/video content from outside.
27. The admitted students must take their food (lunch/dinner) to the hostel mess (in case, the mess is operating). The tiffin from outside campus is not permitted. If any health issues are found to the admitted students due to consumption of food of tiffin/canteen/hotel etc., from outside campus, hotel management is not responsible in any case. In case of any health issue, a request can be made to the hostel mess (in case, the mess is operating) contractor for giving food as per the advice of the doctor. The complaint can be lodged to the food committee regarding inferior food quality/insufficient quantity or for not providing food as per the approved menu at the hostel mess (in case, the mess is operating).
28. Pets are not allowed on the hostel campus.
29. Any student who finds his/her roommate missing for more than 24 hours, he/she must report to the warden and caretaker of the respective hostel immediately. This is to enable the hostel authorities to take immediate action if any untoward incident had taken place. Your cooperation is very much appreciated.
30. Accommodation in the hostel cannot be claimed as a matter of right. Students who disturb the peace and violate the rules of the hostels on campus will be expelled from the hostels.

31. All the hostellers are to note that electrical/carpentry/plumbing complaints should be given in writing to the warden/caretaker or written in the complaint register available with the hostel office. In case, the complaint is not attended to or there is any difficulty, the student can contact the rector.
32. The hostel management reserves the right to make spot checks on the hostel and room without prior notice to the students.

E. Visitors

1. Visitors including parents are allowed solitary into the visitor's area of the hostel only during the visiting hours which are as follows:
 - I. Weekdays (Monday to Friday): 08:30 AM to 10:30 AM
 - II. Weekends (Saturday & Sunday): 08:30 AM to 08:30 PM
2. All visitors will have to make necessary entries in the visitor's book available at the entrance of each hostel and provide documents as requested by the security guard.
3. Female visitors or girl(s) student is not permitted to visit the boys' hostel at any time and in any case.
4. No male or boy(s) student is allowed to visit the girl's hostel.

F. Timing and Absence from Hostel

1. Hostel resident students must return to the hostel late by 10:00 PM every day and are not allowed to leave the hostel before 06:00 AM. The hostel gates remain closed from 10:00 PM to 06:00 AM every day.
2. If any student wants to go out of hostel & college premises, he must make entry to the register for the same.
3. Except during vacations, students shall be allowed to go home only if there is a written request for the same from self/parent/guardian citing genuine grounds and consented by the head of the department he/she belongs to. Going home frequently is not permitted; otherwise, his admission to the hostel will be cancelled.

4. For the overall development of the hostel students, sports facilities are also provided to the students. For indoor games, students have to use the indoor game items inside the room only. No one is allowed to bring any item to their room or anywhere else.
5. The indoor game room will remain closed for college time. The indoor game room will remain open as follows:
 - I. Morning: 09:00 AM to 10:15 AM
 - II. Evening: 06:00 PM to 07:30 PM
6. For outdoor sports, the items will be issued to the respective hostel student only on the submission of the student ID card.
7. A market price or hefty fine (as decided by the hostel management) will be recovered from the identified or all students for missing/damaged sport(s) items.
8. The student should not use the green lavish garden for playing outdoor games such as cricket, volleyball, basketball, football, badminton, etc. They should play such games on the college ground or dedicated space.

G. Emergency

1. In case of any emergency, please contact the security guards at the hostel gate or call the caretaker/warden/college authorities.

H. Disciplinary Measures

1. Any student, who is found to be indulging in undesirable and offensive activities such as ragging, physical assault, property damage, causing inconvenience to other inmates, noncompliance of any of the conduct rules or violation of any other rule stipulated in several clauses under various sections and subsection, shall be subjected to disciplinary action by the hostel authorities as stipulated under the relevant clause after proper enquiry. Moreover, depending upon the gravity of the offence if the hostel management so considers, the case may be forward to the institute disciplinary committee for further necessary action.
2. In some cases, the student may be suspended from the hostel for a period of a few days or weeks as a part of disciplinary measures against his/her offence as decided by the hostel management.

I. Hostel Fees Payment

- All the residents and newly admitted students of the hostels have to pay hostel fees in the given stipulated period only.
- The hostel fees will be collected through the online portal by account section. In case of an emergency, the account section will notify the method of hostel fee payment.
- Most probably, the hostel fees will be collected at the beginning of the new semester.
 - For Odd semesters (Sem 1, Sem 3, Sem 5 & Sem 7): 15th to 31st July.
 - For Even semesters (Sem 2, Sem 4, Sem 6 & Sem 8): 01st to 15th February.
- The hostel admission of the student will be cancelled for non-payment of hostel fees. It is, therefore, compulsory for all hostellers to pay hostel fees in time.
- All the resident students have to pay hostel fees for every academic term till their programme is completed. At present, in the academic year 2022-23, the hostel fee is Rs. 2000/- per semester. The amount of the hostel fee is subject to change as per the decision of the hostel and institute authority.
- The newly admitted student has to pay hostel fees and Caution Money Deposit (CMD) of Rs. 2,000/- at the time of admission. The CMD is the one-time amount to pay which is refundable at the end of the programme on the production of the hostel No Objection Certificate (NOC). The CMD amount is subject to revision as per the decision of the hostel and institute authority.
- The CMD amount will be forfeited to recover the non-paid hostel fees or other hostel charges/penalties.
- The hostel fees (as of Academic Year 2022-23) payment schedule is as per the following table.

At the end of the third week (second chance to pay hostel fees with the penalty), if a student fails to pay the hostel fees his/her admission will be cancelled with immediate effect. No further communication will be entertained in this regard. His/her name will be struck off from the hostel register.

J. Hostel Management Committee

1. The following officers constitute the Hostel Management Committee:
 - III. Principal
 - IV. Rector and/or Assistant Rectors
 - V. Wardens
 - VI. Care Tackers
 - VII. Administrative Staff
2. Each hostel is managed by a warden and a caretaker, and the mess is administrated by the food committee. All the wardens are a member of the food committee.
3. The student can approach any of the above officers for help, guidance and grievance redressed. Representation to higher officers must be forwarded through the hostel management committee only.

K. Hostel Disciplinary Committee

The following officers constitute the Hostel Disciplinary Committee:

- I. Principal
- II. All Head of Department
- III. Rector and/or Assistant Rectors

L. Revision of Rules and Regulations

1. The hostel management reserves the right to revise the rules and regulations from time to time and will keep the resident informed of any changes in the form of notice on the hostel notice board. Ignorance of rules will not be accepted as an excuse.

7. I will maintain my valuables in my own custody. The hostel management is not responsible for any loss or damage.
8. I agree that no entry or exit will be made by me from 10:00 PM to 06:00 AM in the Hostel unless specific permission is taken.
9. I understand that prior permission has to be obtained from the competent authority to visit outside the campus for bonafide purpose; I will be solely responsible for my safety and protection during my departure and return to the Hostel/Institute. In case I leave the hostel/institute without prior permission, Institute can initiate disciplinary action against me and Hostel/Institute authorities are not responsible for my safety.
10. In the event, that I take a leave (with permission) to visit my hometown or other places, I will be solely responsible for my safety and protection during my departure and return to the Hostel/Institute.
11. In the event of my parents/guardians or relatives are visiting me, I will inform the Warden in advance and access/contact them, meeting in the hostel or going out for a local visit will be with the consent of the Warden (Written permission).
12. I understand that no friends or outsiders are allowed on the hostel premises. Also, men cannot go to the women's hostel or vice versa if not otherwise stipulated and any such visit will be seen as serious misconduct, inviting a penalty.

13. I will play a proactive role as a student and suggestions/feedback for improvement or any concerns about aspects of hostel life will be brought to the notice of hostel management immediately.
14. I will strive to play a proactive role in keeping gender amity and maintain cordial & harmonious relations with all, group, individual and authorities on the campus. I understand that the Institute observes a non-negotiable stand concerning the issues of caste, creed and communal harmony.
15. I understand that my involvement in any unacceptable behaviour under the code of conduct and above and any violation of hostel rules will lead to my immediate expulsion from the Hostel/Institute.
16. I will not change my allotted room without permission from the authority.
17. I shall ensure that all dues, including any fines or penalties that may have been imposed against me, are paid in time to the Hostel/Institute.
18. I shall strictly observe and abide by the code of conduct of the Hostel.
